**ORDER**

This matter comes before the court on Plaintiff LM Insurance Corporation's motion for partial summary judgment as to damages filed on December 5, 2025. Mot., ECF No. 37.<sup>1</sup> In that motion, LM Insurance Corporation moved that it be awarded damages in the amount of \$1,023,732.88, jointly and severally, against Defendants Bluestone Resources, Inc., Ranger Fuel Coal Corporation, Blackstone Energy Ltd., Bluestone Coke, LLC, Southeast Cotton, Inc., Bluestone Industries, Inc., Justice Energy Company, Inc., and Kentucky Fuel Corporation (collectively the "Defendants"), representing unpaid premiums on workers compensation and employers liability insurance policies issued to Defendants. This motion for partial summary judgment as to damages follows a Consent Order as to liability entered against Defendants on May 6, 2024. Order, ECF No. 31.

On December 19, 2026, Defendants filed a response to the motion for partial summary judgment stating that "they do not oppose the Motion or the relief requested therein." Resp.,

<sup>1</sup>LM Insurance Corporation filed its motion for partial summary judgment twice at ECF Nos. 36 and 37. ECF 37 is the more complete version as it attaches a memorandum, exhibits and a proposed order, and this Order addresses it. The redundant motion, ECF No. 36, is **DENIED as moot**.

ECF No. 38. As the motion for partial summary judgment, ECF No. 37, is not opposed by Defendants, it is **GRANTED**.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that **JUDGMENT** be entered for Plaintiff LM Insurance Corporation in the amount of \$1,023,732.88, jointly and severally against Defendants Bluestone Resources, Inc., Ranger Fuel Coal Corporation, Blackstone Energy Ltd., Bluestone Coke, LLC, Southeast Cotton, Inc., Bluestone Industries, Inc., Justice Energy Company, Inc., and Kentucky Fuel Corporation.

Following entry of Judgment, the Clerk is directed to close this case.
